

# Block of the Month – June 2011

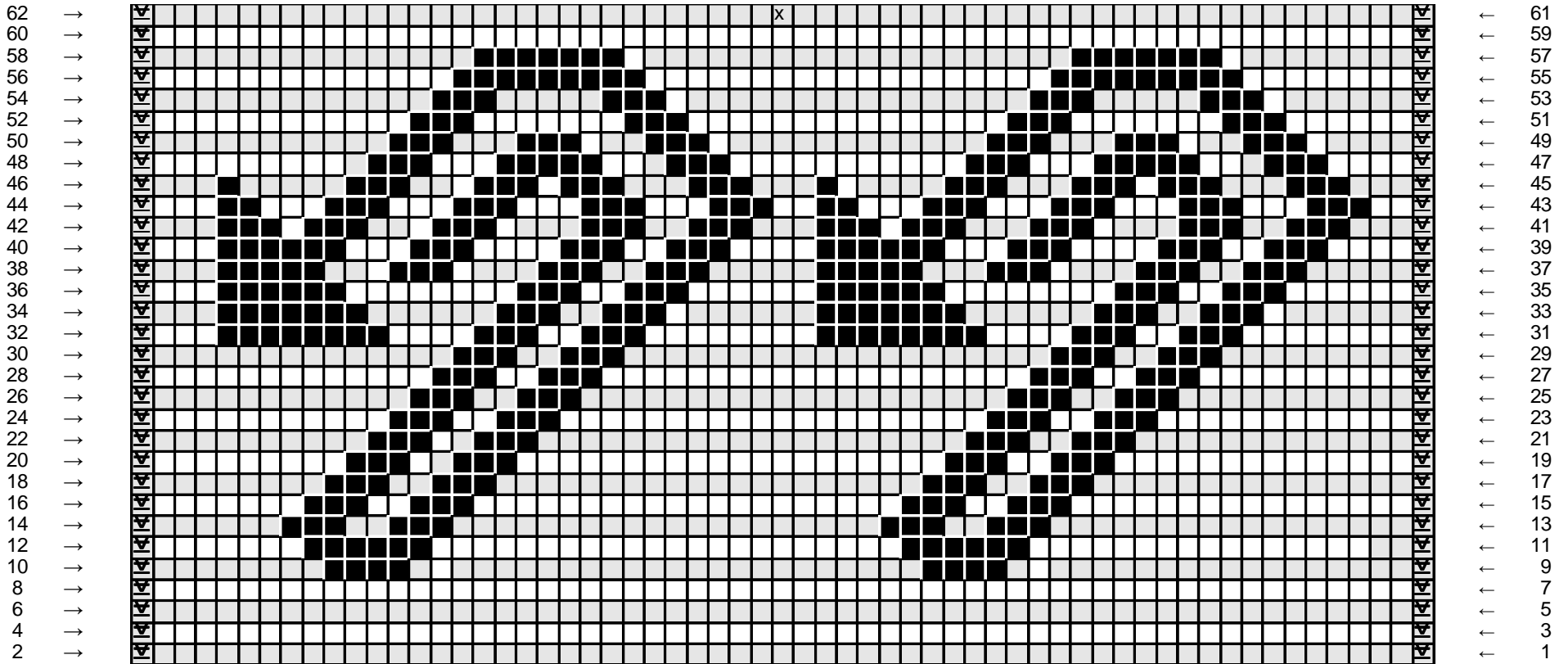
This one can be done in TWO colors, or THREE; you may use any combination of contrasting colors. The pattern is shown in black and white squares; the gray squares are shown just to aid in following the rows.

Also, this particular stitch pattern can be changed so that the arrows point left or right, up or down, simply by reversing or flipping each section of the chart.

Cast on 61; knit every row; slip first stitch with yarn in front, knit last stitch (the chart shows rows doubled, do not slip the last stitch of any row.).  
Odd numbered rows, knit the chart right to left; subsequent even numbered rows, knit the chart left to right the same colors as the odd row just knit.  
Even rows, you will carry yarns on the FRONT of the work, so all floats and joins are hidden on the BACK side of the square when completed. You will twist all intarsia color changes, and all color stranding changes by bringing the working color to the back, move new color up and under the strand and moving it to the front of the work.

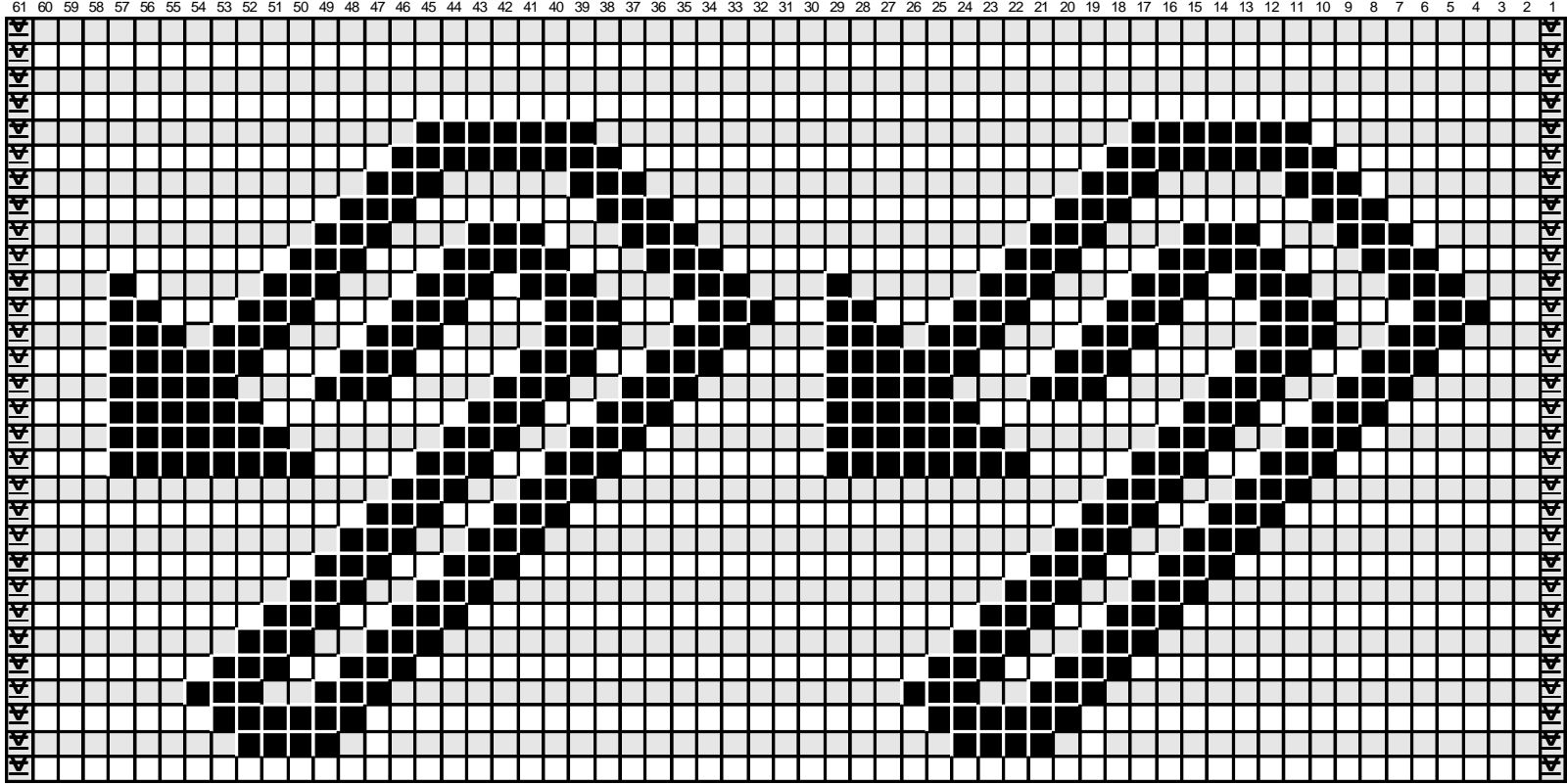
